

District Park Facilities

The operation and maintenance of District owned Park and Recreation facilities are paid for by the proceeds from CFD 94-1.

The **North Tahoe Regional Park** in Tahoe Vista has more than 100 acres of open space to enjoy. Amenities includes a disc golf course, ballfields, all weather soccer field, par course, dog park, children's playground, Ramada picnic area, hiking and biking trails groomed in the winter for cross country skiing, and a paved bike trail that connects to Pine Drop Drive off of Highway 267 for easy walking and biking access to the Park.

Tahoe Vista Recreation

Area is the District's newest facility and is located at the intersection of Highway 28 and National Avenue in Tahoe Vista. This lakefront recreation facility includes a boat launch, restrooms and a large plaza area available for rent.

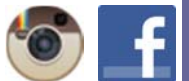

What is the Park Supporter Program?



Park Supporters and CFD 94-1 supports recreation and parks in our community

The Park Supporter Program was created to allow those that do not live in the North Tahoe Public Utility District, but enjoy the District's amenities, to support the Parks at a level similar to our residents and in return receive the same benefits. The cost is \$100.

The residents of the North Tahoe Public Utility District passed CFD 94-1 in 1992; a Mello Roos assessment to support the North Tahoe Regional Park and other recreational opportunities. Funds collected from this tax measure support operations and management of the District's Park facilities and provide an annual subsidy to the Boys and Girls Club of North Lake Tahoe which operates recreational programs for the youth in the community.



CFD 94-1 provides approximately \$612,000 in 2017 for the upkeep, operation and maintenance of District facilities and to



Who is Eligible to be a Park Supporter?

The District welcomes anyone that wishes to support our Park Facilities to be a Park Supporter! Whether you are a disc golfer, a parent with children that enjoy the playground and the ball fields, or you bring your dog to play in the dog park or walk on the trails; if you regularly enjoy and utilize amenities in the North Tahoe Regional Park and/or the Tahoe Vista Recreation Area, we welcome and encourage you to join our residents in contributing to their maintenance and upkeep.

What benefits do I get?


The \$100 annual fee provides the same benefits as our residents. The program allows free parking at the North Tahoe Regional Park. New for 2017, free passenger vehicle parking and discounted boat launch rates at Tahoe Vista Recreation Area. The Benefit Program offers discounted rates for use of Regional Park facilities such as the Ramada group picnic area, tennis

courts and ball fields and a 10% discount with all District concessionaires.
