**Tahoe Vista Recreation Area (TVRA) Boat Launch Policies
Non-Commercial Use Only**

This season pass is not valid for commercial launching. **All commercial operators or anyone renting their boat or other motorized watercraft must have a Tahoe Regional Planning Agency concessionaire permit.**

This season pass includes boat/trailer parking if parking is available at the TVRA parking lot. Overnight parking of vehicles or trailers is not permitted in the TVRA parking lot.

Overnight parking or storage of boats is not permitted in the Tahoe Vista Recreation Area harbor or parking lot.

Boats below 25' in length are best suited for TVRA, although the launch can accommodate larger boats depending on lake level.

TVRA boat launch can typically accommodate boats with up to 3' of the draft when the Lake is at or above the natural rim. However, note that water levels and lake bottom contour can change during the season, and it is advisable to check current conditions before launching.

2020 Hours/Day of Operations – **These days and times are subject to change due to health directives, weather and staffing.** Please follow Tahoe Vista Recreation Area and Boat Launch on Facebook or check the website for updates.

Hours: 7 AM – 7 PM

Opening Day: 5/22/20 (Friday of Memorial Day Weekend – Boat launch will be open Friday 5/22/20 – Monday 5/24/20 of Memorial Day Weekend.)

Friday, Saturday and Sunday only until 6/14/20

7 Days a Week 6/15/20 – 9/13/20 (Sunday after Labor Day)

Friday, Saturday and Sunday only from 9/18 through 9/27/20

Under guidance from the County of Placer and State of California and in response to the COVID-19 pandemic, the District has formulated a Protection Plan which is posted at TVRA and can be found at northtahoe.com/boat-launches. Boat launch users must adhere to guidelines as outlined in the Plan. When pulling out boats out of the water, please make use of the Courtesy Docks along the sea wall to drop off the person going to get your tow vehicle and trailer instead of taking up space at the ramp. If possible, then move your boat out of the dock area until your vehicle and trailer are lined up to back in.

Per the Tahoe Shoreline Plan, motorized vessels are not permitted in the swim area or on the beach. Please follow all TRPA Shoreline Plan regulations relating to the “No Wake Zone”.

The North Tahoe Public Utility District is not responsible for accidents, injuries or loss of property. All users understand that use of the TVRA boat launch includes the potential risk of damage or injury and all users are voluntarily choosing to use the TVRA boat launch. By signing this form, users are voluntarily releasing and forever discharging the North Tahoe Public Utilities District (NTPUD), its agents, officials, officers, employees, and volunteers from any liability related to use of the TVRA boat launch and for any injury, death, illness or disease, and damage. Users waive any and all rights that they may have to make a claim against, or to sue, the NTPUD for any loss or damage that may accrue against the NTPUD, its agents, officials, officers, employees, and volunteers, arising out of the use of the TVRA boat launch by reason of negligence or otherwise. Users further agree to indemnify and save free and harmless the NTPUD from any claims, liability, or loss occasioned to the NTPUD as the result of injury or death to persons or damage to property arising out of the use of the TVRA boat launch pursuant to the reasons for this waiver by reason of negligence or otherwise.

Park boat launch facilities are furnished solely for the convenience of Park users, and by using the facilities, users do so at their own risk.

No garbage, trash, oil, fuel, debris or other material, liquid or solid, shall be deposited in the launch area/ramp or within parking areas, except as specified in notices besides waste into the containers provided for that specific purpose.

Refueling watercraft over-water or in boat ramp area is strictly prohibited.

This season pass DOES NOT INCLUDE the REQUIRED Aquatic Invasive Species inspections or a Tahoe Only Sticker for boats entering Lake Tahoe. Boats MUST be inspected and display inspection sticker before arriving at the launch.
