## Tahoe Vista Recreation Area Boat Launch Policies for Commercial Use

By signing this agreement, I agree to abide by the rules and limitations set forth below. In consideration for, and in consideration of, the use of a 2020 TVRA BOAT LAUNCH COMMERCIAL SEASON PASS. Failure to comply with any part of this agreement may result in loss of Commercial launch privileges at the TVRA Marina and Boat Launch.

I, \_\_\_\_\_ agree to as follows:

1. **Season Pass:** Commercial Operator shall purchase one (1) TVRA Commercial Season Pass per vessel to be launched or exited from the boat ramp. Passes must be purchased through the District Offices during regular business hours. This can be done via email (customerservice@ntpud.org) or dropping all required documentation off via the District's Night Drop Box. There are no refunds for season passes.
2. **Business License:** Commercial Operator shall provide District with a copy of their current Placer County Business License.
3. **Insurance:** District shall be named as Additional Insured with Endorsements in minimum amounts of \$1,000,00 per occurrence, \$2,000,000 aggregate on a) General Liability Insurance; and b) Commercial Marine Liability Insurance.
4. **Waiver of Liability and Indemnification:** The North Tahoe Public Utility District is not responsible for accidents, injuries, or loss of property. All users understand that use of the TVRA boat launch includes the potential risk of damage or injury, and all users are voluntarily choosing to use the TVRA boat launch. By signing this form, users, on behalf of themselves, their employees, agents, customers and contractors, are voluntarily releasing and forever discharging the North Tahoe Public Utility District (NTPUD), its agents, officials, officers, employees, and volunteers from any liability related to use of the TVRA boat launch and for any injury, death, illness or disease, and damage. Users waive any and all rights that they may have to make a claim against, or to sue, the NTPUD for any loss or damage that may accrue against the NTPUD, its agents, officials, officers, employees, and volunteers, arising out of the use of the TVRA boat launch by reason of negligence or otherwise. Users further agree to indemnify and save free and harmless the NTPUD from any claims, liability, or loss occasioned to the NTPUD as the result of injury or death to persons or damage to property arising out of the use of the TVRA boat launch pursuant to the reasons for this waiver by reason of negligence or otherwise. Users shall include waiver and indemnity language consistent with this section in contracts, liability waivers and similar documents from all customers, volunteers, subcontractors, and agents, which shall be subject to NTPUD's prior review and approval. A waiver and indemnity shall be obtained from each customer, volunteer, subcontractor, or agent utilizing the TVRA boat launch.
5. **Commercial Operators must provide a copy of their waiver that each customer, volunteer, subcontractor or agent utilizing the TVRA boat launch will sign, showing the language as required above.**
6. **Operations:**
  - a. Commercial Operator SHALL obey all TRPA noise and wake zone Ordinances.
  - b. Commercial Operator SHALL NOT conduct any business transactions while on, or within, the properties of the TVRA Marina and Boat Launch, including the beach and parking lots of TVRA.
  - c. Commercial Operator SHALL NOT impact or interfere with the operation of TVRA Marina and Boat Launch by District personnel or District concessionaires.
  - d. Commercial Operator SHALL NOT park trailer or personal vehicles in the short-term parking spaces at the TVRA parking lot for a time exceeding the posted time limit(s), either 15- or 30-minutes.
  - e. Commercial Operator SHALL NOT "set-up shop" or casually loiter at the TVRA Marina and Boat Launch, which includes the beach area of TVRA.
  - f. Refueling watercraft in the TVRA Marina, boat ramp area, or TVRA parking lot is strictly prohibited.
  - g. No garbage, trash, oil, fuel, debris or other material, liquid or solid, shall be deposited in the TVRA Marina, boat ramp area, or within parking areas, except as specified in notices besides waste into the containers provided for that specific purpose.
7. **Boat and Trailer Parking:**
  - a. Commercial Operator shall moor their boats on TRPA-approved and permitted moorings or they shall remove their boats from the TVRA Marina and Boat Launch daily.
  - b. Commercial Operators shall be permitted to moor their boats at the TVRA courtesy docks for no more than fifteen (15) minutes at a time. Boats that are moored at the courtesy docks for more than fifteen (15) minutes will be subject to loss of launch privileges.
  - c. No overnight parking is allowed on or in the vicinity of the courtesy or floating docks.
  - d. The TVRA trailer parking area is for short-term (day use) parking only for visitors and guests using the TVRA Marina and Boat Launch after they've launched their boats. Commercial Operators SHALL NOT be permitted to park loaded trailers in the TVRA parking lot overnight, while staging, or queuing for rentals.
8. **Planned Hours of Operation: 2020 Hours and Days of Operation – Subject to change due to health directives, weather and/or staffing. Please follow Tahoe Vista Recreation Area and Boat Launch on Facebook for updates.**
  - a. **Public Hours: 7 AM – 7 PM – Commercial Operators shall have a dedicated hour, between 6:00am and 7:00am when ramp is open, to exit/put in their vessels. Commercial Operators are strongly encouraged to notify District of intent to exit or launch during these times and to limit all other exits to within an hour of the ramp closing.**
  - b. **District will follow current COVID-19 guidance as applicable and restrictive measures may be placed and enforced.**
  - c. **Friday, Saturday and Sunday only from Opening through 6/14/20. Monday of Memorial Day Weekend will be open.**
  - d. **7 Days a Week 6/15/20 – 9/13/20 (Sunday after Labor Day); Friday, Saturday and Sunday only from 9/18/20 through 9/27/20.**
